

Old Is New At Coronation Hall



Built in 1936 as a dance hall, Coronation Hall was the go-to place for locals and summertime tourists from Montreal and Ottawa in Bristol Village. Abandoned in the 1960s, it remained closed until it was brought back to life as a venue for dances, parties, theatre and concerts, and then paired with a new cider mill and tea room and reborn as Coronation Hall Cider Mills in 2008.

Using local fruit from their

orchard, they make fresh and delicious sweet apple ciders, raspberry and strawberry ciders, apple pies, cookies, and many treats for you to sample and enjoy. They also produce hard apple cider and new this year a delicious sparkling cider! Sit and enjoy treats in the tea room while checking out the unique and interesting arts and boutique gifts.

Coronation Hall is open for tours of the cider mill, tastings,

and demonstrations. You can make your visit extra special by booking a wagon ride (or sleigh ride in the winter) through the scenic countryside and forest, or come and experience the 'Under the Pines' music festival in July, the Bristol Summer Theatre festival in August and 'AppleFest' on Thanksgiving Saturday.

from May 1st until December 23rd, Tuesdays till Sundays, 10:00am to 4:00pm.
