

8 NEAT CAMPING GADGETS

Nemo Helio Pressure Shower www.nemoequipment.com

An alternative to a bag shower, Helio sits on the ground full of 2.9 gallons of hot water (if you let it sit in the sun long enough). A foot pump provides pressure to the water and forces it out the 7-foot neoprene hose. Can be used for dishes, or on the family dog when he finds a skunk. Fold it up in a backpack when it's empty.

If you'd rather your batteries didn't depend on sunlight, this might be for you. It converts hydrogen gas into electricity. The puck cartridge inside produces the juice and dispenses it via USB port to power your mobile device. It also creates another

juicewater vapor. It'll trickle charge a device at night, producing 2.5 watts at 5 volts for about two hours. The lid of the PowerTrekk has a battery in it you can charge before you even pack your camping gear, so it's ready without using the hydrogen puck.

These binoculars zoom from 0.8x to 25x in an instant and they can also record what you're seeing in 3D and keep the picture steady with image stabilization. You can record to several kinds of Sony

Memory Sticks for storage and transfer to a computer.

Get some campsite cooking done while also powering your USB-based devices. BioLite is a tiny stove that holds up to 1.6 ounces of twigs, which is enough to boil one liter of water in about 4.5 minutes. It uses the heat generated to turn a fan-powered generator that supplies 20 minutes of charging time to an iPhone. The latest addition is a 55-square-inch grill top that folds up for storage.
