2014 marks the 120th anniversary of the arrival of rail in the Madawaska Valley. On Saturdays between July 19th and August 2nd you can participate in Making Tracks, a community fibre installation to reconstruct the rail line through Railway Station Park in Barry's Bay. Enjoy Music in the Park Fridays in August at 6:30pm. The show



on August 8th features train songs, followed by an original dance performance and the unveiling of the fibre rail line.
